### RUSTIC STAY

An overnight stay on board *Schulschiff Deutschland* is a very special experience. A total of 30 cabins with bunks on top of each other are available for individual travelers or groups. The bunks are equipped with bed linen and towels and have shared bathrooms.

Brand new in the program: the family room with a double bed and a bunk bed.

If you want something more comfortable, choose the captain's suite with salon, shipowner's room, study, shower and toilet. Sparkling wine for breakfast is included.

Bicycle tourists will find storage space for their bikes, including charging options for e-bikes.

### TYING THE KNOT

Weddings on board, civil or religious, are the perfect start to marriage. The civil weddings take place in the captain's lounge (with a maxi-mum of 15 people).

Beforehand, the wedding party meets in the former ship's hospital, which has now become a museum.

# SCHULSCHIFF DEUTSCHLAND

THE LAST GERMAN FULL SHIP FOR A SPECIAL EXPERIENCE

From Rio de Janeiro to Buenos Aires, from the Bahamas to Cape Town in South Africa, from Venezuela to the Canary Islands: The crew on board the sailing training ship that was launched in Bremerhaven on June 14, 1927 and was christened Training Ship Deutschland, has travelled the world.

Go on board and experience the maritime past. Not only can you visit the tall ship, you can also spend the night on board, celebrate, hold meetings – or tie the knot.

## THE SHIP

*Schulschiff Deutschland* is a fully rigged ship, which means all three masts are rigged. The foremast is 50 m high, the main mast is 52m and the mizzen mast is 48m. Training ship Deutschland measures 1,257 GRT (769 NRT). The displacement is 1,470 tons. The fixed ballast in the hull weighs 560 tons.

A stell, i.e. a complete set of sails, included 25 sails with a total of 1,950 m<sup>2</sup>.

Length of the hull: 73.50 m

Width: 11.98 m,

Draft: 5.45 m

*Schulschiff Deutschland* was built under construction number 417 by Joh. C. Tecklenborg in Bremerhaven-Geestemünde and cost 920,000 Reichsmarks at the time. The money was raised by the German Training Ship Association, the State of Prussia, the Senates in Bremen and Hamburg as well as donations from large shipping companies.

Georg W. Claussen, the world's leading sailing ship designer of his time, had designed the ship specifically as a training sailing ship.

Up to 140 "students" completed twelve extensive sea voyages, trained by a regular crew of 24 men, between 1927 and 1939. Since then the ship has sailed across the North and Baltic Seas to Helsinki 16 times.

## VISITS

*Schulschiff Deutschland* is centrally located in the New Harbor directly on Lloyd-Platz in Bremerhaven - in the center of the Havenwelten and therefore surrounded by exciting knowledge and experience exhibitions, the shopping mile and museums. The historic tall ship can be visited here every day. Guided tours are also offered for groups of 10 or more people upon prior registration.
